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Onyx Horizon Systems Limited began with a habit of looking closely. We notice patterns in the systems people live inside: where a process serves them, where its purpose has grown difficult to see, and where a small correction might open a better path.

We are in Year 0: one human being, one company, and four divisions. Onyx Horizon is a vessel for my independent research in anthropology and theology, not a software company. An inquiry may need the patience of a book, the feeling of music, the reach of digital media, or the discipline of a public-interest proposal. The form follows the work.

Our four divisions give those forms a home: Amethyst House Publishing for books and long-form writing; Onyx Soundworks for music; Onyx Horizon Network for digital media; and Fulmen Amethystinum for originating concepts addressed to government and institutions. Some work is ready to read. Other ideas remain open for examination and correction.

I build carefully, invite scrutiny, and ask what each piece helps people understand, make, or restore. The measure is whether the work leaves the systems it touches healthier than it found them.
